

Many do not receive because of one of two reasons

1. They have no seed in the ground (A lot of words prophesied to people will not happen because God works through ONE Kingdom principle – SEED)
 - a. The seed is in the deed of doing Gods word. Many prophesy to people that God is going to do something for that person, but they are not and will not do the word. God does not operate that way. He does NOTHING apart from His Word.
 - b. Every promise of God is a prophesy of what God is going to do to them who do it
2. They give up too quickly

How to receive

- Determine if it is Gods will **1Jn 5:14-15**
 - a. Ask according to His will
 - i. You cannot ask for something He has not promised **Mar 10:35-40**
 - ii. If you know the gift and the giver **Joh 4:10**
 - iii. If His Words abide in you, you can ask **Joh 15:7**
 - iv. All Gods promises in Him are YES AND AMEN **2Co 1:19-20**
- ASK FOR IT
 - a. You have not because you ask not **Jas 4:2-3**
- ASK 38 times in N.T
 - a. A.S.K There is more to ask than just asking for something
 - b. You Father knows what you need before you ask **Mat 6:8**
 - c. Ask and it shall be given seek and you will find knock and it will be opened **Matt 7:7**
 - d. God will give good things to them that ask him **Matt 7:9-11**
 - e. God will give the Holy Spirit to them that ask **Luk 11:11-13**
 - f. ALL things you ask believe you receive them and you will have them **Matt 21:22; Mar 11:24**
 - g. Ask anything in His name **Joh 14:13-14 Joh 15:16; Joh 16:23-24**
 - h. God will do exceedingly abundantly above **Eph 3:20**
 - i. What we ask we receive if we keep His commandments **1Jn 3:22**
- How to ask A.S.K **Jas 1:6-8**
 - a. Ask is in the continual tense (always right now) **Mat 7:7-11 AMP**
 - b. A – Ask
 - i. Ask and Keep on Asking **1Th 5:17; Luk 18:1-8**
 - ii. Refuse to take NO **Mar 7:26-30**
 - c. S – Seek
 - i. To make a demand on God to do What HE said.
 - d. K – Knock
 - i. To continue to demand God to do it **Act 12:13-16**
 - ii. Importunity – Recklessness, audacity, shamelessness, insolence. Recklessness or disregard of consideration by the one making the request **Luk 11:5-8**
