

Entering YOUR salvation

Eph 1:13 The good news of YOUR Salvation

- Salvation – Soteria; Rescue from loss or harm. generally, meaning welfare, prosperity, victory, deliverance from present danger or trouble, from defeat, deliverance from the future condemnation; deliverance from sin and its consequences.
 - **Heb 11:7** Noah was saved by faith; **Exo 14:13** They saw it but had to walk into it; **2Ch 20:17** The battle was the Lords, but they had to go out
- It is yours but you must enter that Salvation by Faith

Rom 10:1-4

- Did not enter in because of unbelief **Heb 3:7-19**
- The work was finished but they didn't enter, it remains for us to enter **Heb 4:1-6**
- We are to labor to enter **Heb 4:9-11**
- It is your own salvation (deliverance; rescue), but you must work it out (Walk it out) **Php 2:12**

Rom 10:5-10

- Not working for Salvation I am working OUT MY Salvation that Christ obtained for me

Gods' method of entering has always been the same **Josh 1:8; Deu 30:12-14**. (The one you must persuade is yourself)

1. Confess with your mouth (First)
 - a. Confession of faith leads one to believe
 - b. Faith comes by Hearing and Hearing **Rom 10:17**
 - c. The More I confess the Word the more I build faith in my heart
2. Believe in your heart (Second)
 - a. When I believe I will have **Mar 16:16**
 - b. He that hears and believes has **Joh 5:24**
 - c. The More I believe on The Son it creates a witness (Evidence) in me that I have **1Jn 5:10**
3. Until you Act on the Word **Joh 14:12; Luk 6:45-49**
 - a. Hear and DO **Mat 7:24-27**
 - b. I Must BECOME a Doer of the Word, then I will enter MY SALVATION **Jas 1:22-25**
