

God was in Christ reconciling - Reconciling – Getting rid of the old and making the new

- Reconcile – Katallasso – To make different by exchange
 - The first man Adam was earthy or made from the earth **1Co 15:45-49; Gen 2:7**
 - The Second Man God made in Christ
 - Making one new man **Eph 2:13-16**
- The first man was made from the dirt of the earth the second man was made from His Son
 - God made Him to be sin for us **2Co 5:21**
 - Made Him a body to condemn sin in **Heb 10:4-10**
 - God condemned sin in His flesh **Rom 8:3; Isa 53:10-12**

Put off the former man conversation (behavior) **Eph 4:22** (notice the old man is still there trying to operate)

- Through Jesus is how we are freed from the old man **Rom 7:20-25**
- We are DAILY going through the means through which Christ has provided for us to be saved. **Php 3:10-11; 1Co 15:31**

The way to put off the old man is through His cross **Mat 10:38; Mat 16:24; Mar 8:34; Luk 9:23** (daily) **Luk 14:27**

- The cross is how we are freed from our old man and our sin **1Co 1:18**
 - The cross is offensive to religion **Gal 5:11**
 - The cross brings persecution **Gal 6:12**
 - The cross brings separation **Gal 6:14**
- Identify the old man **1Co 6:9-11**
 - The reason they were acting the way they were was because they were still identifying with the old man. Paul was reminding them of who they are in Christ.
- Judge Him - **1Co 11:31**
 - Once you identify your old man, judge Him (pass sentence on Him)
- Condemn and crucify Him DAILY
 - **Gal 2:20 I AM** (continually) not I was
- Do not allow him to operate through you **Col 3:9; Rom 6:6-14**

The way we put on the new man is through Faith in the resurrection and the New Man in Christ
Discover the New Man God made in Christ

- Know you not – Paul’s favorite phrase (19 verses) **Rom 6:3; Rom 6:16; 1Co 3:16; 1Co 6:15-20; 2Co 13:5**
- Embrace Him and confess Him **Heb 11:13**
- Behave and live according to that New Man in Christ **Rom 13:14; Eph 4:24; Col 3:10**
