

Walk in the same steps (tracks) of Abraham

- Every miracle that Jesus performed by the faith of the individual was received by a specific type of faith. It is the God kind of faith **Mark 11:22**
1. He was hearing God
 - a. Promise Means an announcement
 - i. With God a promise is never what He is going to do but what He has already done.
 - b. Faith comes by hearing and hearing the (Rhema) spoken Word of God **Rom 10:17**
 - c. Speaking to His Church Jesus said, "He that has ears let Him hear" **Rev 2:7; Rev 2:11; Rev 2:17; Rev 2:29; Rev 3:6; Rev 3:13; Rev 3:22**
 - d. We must be converted by hearing **Mat 13:15**
 - e. The promise begins working as we are hearing and mixing the God kind of faith **Heb 4:2; Mar 5:25-34**
 2. He imitated God who gives life to dead things and calls things that be not **Rom 4:17**
 - a. He didn't call things as though they would be He called them as though they WERE
 - b. He called things that did not exist as though they did exist
 - c. We are the conduit through which Gods Word is released into our lives **Mk 11:23; Rom 10:8-10**
 3. He did not consider the circumstances of impossibility or his inability to make it happen **Rom 4:18-21**
 - a. Considered not – He did not take into consideration whether it would happen based on his ability to make it happen **2Co 4:13-18;**
 - b. We walk by faith **2Co 5:7**
 - i. Walk means how we live and move and have our being. The way we operate our life. We are to live this way! **Hab 2:4; Rom 1:17; Gal 3:11; Heb 10:38**
 - ii. There is a great attack on this message because the carnal person always resists the Spirit of God **1Co 2:14** (Two types of Wisdom **Jas 3:15-18; Jud 1:17-19**)
