1. What "Garments of Shame" might you be wearing now, or have in the past?
2. The "young man" motif from Mark is an illustration of the brilliance of Mark as a work of literature to teach us about God and ourselves. Are there any other examples from Mark like this that have stuck out to you as beautiful works of storytelling?
3. What characters do you identify with in the resurrection story? The disciples? The women? Joseph? Jesus? The young man? In what ways?
4. What does "Garment of Glory" mean to you? What does the Bible teach about the glory awaiting those who follow Jesus on the Way?
5. What rhythms or disciplines can help you remember and live into the truth of the restoration available in Jesus? How can your community group help you?
