



## Community Group Questions

### Read the verses: Mark 11:1-11

Remembering the Passion Week of Christ and His Resurrection  
Spending extra time reflectively reading through the events surrounding the "Passion Week."

Sunday - The Triumphal Entry – Mark 11:1-11; Matthew 21:1-11; Luke 19:28-44;  
John 12:12-19

What was the question everyone was asking? What was the message Jesus was sending?

Why did Jesus weep over Jerusalem?

What does this scene tell you about Jesus' love for you?

Monday and Tuesday – The Conflict – Mark 11:12 – 13:36; Luke 19:45—22:38

Why do you believe Jesus was locked in conflict with the religious leaders?

What was their attitude? What revealed their unbelief?

What is your attitude toward Jesus? What do you believe about him? Express it to Him.

Wednesday – Judas Betrayal – Mark 14:1-11; Luke 22:1-6; Matthew 26:14-16; 47-56; 27:1-10

Why do you feel Judas betrayed Jesus? Why is this story so sad?

Are there any ways you have betrayed Jesus? Confess those ways to him, repent and recommit to Him.

Thursday – The Last Supper / The Lord's Prayer / Gethsemane - Mark 14:12-26; John 17:1-26; Luke 22:1-19;  
Matthew 26:36-56

What does Jesus' example with the basin and the towel teach you as his disciple?

What does Jesus teaching his disciples with communion?

What do we learn about Jesus' love in Gethsemane that night?

What do you learn about the importance and power of prayer?

Enter into the twenty-four hour prayer and fasting time

Friday – The Crucifixion and Burial – Luke 23:26-56; John 18, 19

What do you learn about the extent of God's love for you at the crucifixion of Christ?

Saturday - The Resurrection - Luke 24; John 20; 1 Corinthians 15:1-20.

Why is the truth of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ so vital for us?

What would be true if the Resurrection didn't happen?

What is true because it did happen?
