- 2. In Mark 6:7-9, 30-32: Mark is inviting the reader to remember a story from the OT. What is the story and how might Mark be using it to make a point about following Jesus? (Hint: the word "desolate place" is also called "wilderness")
- 3. Why is Jesus a better King than Herod in this story from Mark 6? List all the reasons you can see.
- 4. How does a follower of Jesus find a balance between sacrifice and rest, or extending Jesus' mission and being with Him?
- 5. What calling of Jesus on your life might you not be engaging with because the cost might be too high?
