Read the verses: John 20:24-31

Read John 20:1-31

- 1. Take a moment to reflect on the heart of Jesus in these three post-resurrection appearances. What idk you think is His motive? His desire? What is He asking of Mary Magdalene, the disciples, and Thomas?
- 2. Thomas has some specific "unless" demands in v25. Is there anything you demand before trusting in Jesus and his promises?
- 3. What do we learn from Thomas's confession in v28?
- 4. What does it look like for Jesus to be Lord and God of your life?
- 5. What encouragement can we take from Jesus in v29?
- 6. Take a moment to pray for people in your life that they may believe in Jesus. Ask God to give you the words and wisdom to share Christ with them.

BONUS: As we finish the "This is Jesus" series, take a moment to reflect on what you have learned about Jesus from this series in John. Do any of these encounters with Jesus stick out in your mind? Why?
