

Community Group Questions

Read the verses: John 6

For Context, read or briefly summarize John 6:1-21.

Now take a few minutes to read aloud John 6:22-71.

1. What is Jesus trying to teach the crowd about himself?

2. How has Jesus provided for you in "the wilderness"?

3. What are some reasons you think it was difficult for the people to accept Jesus' teaching?

4. Is there any teaching in Scripture you find difficult to understand or accept?

5. What are some teachings of the Bible that have caused people in your life to walk away from Jesus?

6. How does Peter's response guide us today (vv 67-69)?

7. Come to Jesus as the Provider: I encourage your group to lay before Jesus your needs, however momentary or basic they may seem, knowing that He delights with a compassionate heart in providing for us as the Father wills. (see Phil 4:6, 1 Peter 5:7)

8. Believe in Jesus as the Provision: I invite everyone in your group to take Jesus at His word and believe in him as the Bread of Life. Receive Him as the provision for your sin and move from death to eternal life. If all in the group believe, then praise God and pray that He might call those you know who have yet to believe to come to Jesus.

9. Abide in Jesus our Lord: I encourage your group to spend time in solemn prayer. Lay at the feet of the cross any teachings of Christ that may be difficult to understand or accept. Submit to Jesus' lordship and trust Him, remain in Him, abide in Him - as He abides in you. Thank Jesus for promising to never cast you out as you believe in Him (John 6:37-40).
