Read the verses: Matthew 12:9-37

- 1. See if your group can collectively summarize the portion of Matthew that we have covered so far (Chapters 1-11). Feel free to use your Bibles as reference.
- 2. Read Matthew 12:1-14.
- a. How would you describe the character of Jesus and His Kingdom from this passage
- b. How would you describe the character of the Pharisees from this passage?
- c. On your path to becoming like Jesus, how can you look more like Him this week?
- 3. Read Matthew 12:22-37.
- a. What was Jesus doing, by whose power, and for what reason?
- b. What is the Pharisee's accusation?
- c. How would you summarize Jesus' response?
- 4. Why do you think Jesus is so stern specifically concerning blasphemy of the Holy Spirit?
- a. What advice would you give someone who rejects Jesus as the Son of God?
- b. Does this passage mean someone who has faith in Jesus could accidentally commit a sin that will not be forgiven? Why or Why not?
- 5. vv. 33-37 The good tree and the bad tree.
- a. Jesus' teaching in Matthew often includes a dichotomy. This passage mentions the good tree with good fruit and the bad tree with bad fruit. What other comparisons from Jesus' teaching come to mind?
- b. What makes the fruit bad or good?
- c. Why are our words so important?
- 6. Pray by name for loved ones and others who have rejected Jesus to return to Him and see Him as the Holy Spirit has revealed Him: The Son of God, the Savior of the World, the only way to the Father, the one who can forgive the sins of all those who trust in Him.
