

Community Group Questions

Read the verses: Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-35; John 1:1-14

- 1. Reread Matthew 1:18-25; Luke 1:26-35. What does the Angel reveal to Joseph and Mary about this baby? Why is the miracle of the Virgin Birth of Jesus such a vital part of the story of Christmas? What does the angel tell Joseph and Mary about who Jesus was?
- 2. What was Joseph's and Mary's response? What should be our response?
- 3. Read John 1:1-14. John gives a more theological version of the Christmas Story. What does he tell us about who Jesus was? Why is it important to know that Jesus was God before he became a man and that he didn't stop being God when he became a man? That is called the Incarnation of Christ Jesus was both fully God and fully man housed in a human body.
- 4. How does the Miracle or the Virgin Birth and the Mystery of the Incarnation describe the extent of God's love for us?
- 5. Some other verses to consider: Romans 5:8 1 John 4:10,11
- 6. How do you respond to such love? (Have people in the group give one-word responses) John 15:9 As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you. Abide (remain) in my love. 1 John 31 What Marvelous love the Father has extended to us! Just look at it we're called the children of God! That's who we really are. (MSG)
