**Read the verses: Matthew 22:37, 1 John 4:19, Matthew 10:37, Proverbs 3:5-8, Matthew 26:39, Psalm 63:1**

1. Who or what do you love most? Why?
2. How would you describe your love for God? What does it look like? What does it feel like? How does it relate to your other loves?
3. Read Matthew 22:34-40. In light of the context, how is Jesus qualifying our love for God? Can love be commanded? Why or why not?
4. Read Matthew 10:34-39. In light of the context, how is Jesus qualifying our love for Him? Is this a fair statement? Why or why not?
5. Jon said "A supremely loveable God is to be supremely loved." Do you agree? How would you say this in your own words?
6. What makes God supremely loveable? Spend time on this sharing different attributes and works of God both found in Scripture or seen in life.
7. In what ways big and small can you cultivate a supreme love for God?
8. In what ways can our corporate gatherings be informed by a supreme love for God?
9. In what ways can our love for others be informed by a supreme love for God?
10. End in prayer simply telling God you love Him and some reasons why You love Him.
