- 1. Who or what do you love most? Why?
- 2. How would you describe your love for God? What does it look like? What does it feel like? How does it relate to your pther loves?
- 3. Read Matthew 22:34-40. In light of the context, how is Jesus qualifying our love for God? Can love be commanded? Why or why not?
- 4. Read Matthew 10:34-39. In light of the context, how is Jesus qualifying our love for Him? Is this a fair statement? Why or why not?
- 5. Jon said "A supremely loveable God is to be supremely loved." Do you agree? How would you say this in your own words?
- 6. What makes God supremely loveable? Spend time on this sharing different attributes and works of God both found in Scripture or seen in life.
- 7. In what ways big and small can you cultivate a supreme love for God?
- 8. In what ways can our corporate gatherings be informed by a supreme love for God?
- 9. In what ways can our love for others be informed by a supreme love for God?
- 10. End in prayer simply telling God you love Him and some reasons why You love Him.
