### Read the verses: 1 Corinthians 15

2. What did Paul consider to be "first importance" when it comes to Christian doctrine? In your experience, what issues have been "first importance" in different churches or Christian communities you have been a part of?
3. How can we keep the most essential things and not elevate other things to the level of "first importance" or downplay issues that should be of first importance?
4. Our culture can be obsessed with image and achieving the perfect body/look or say our bodies/look doesn't matter. How can we think like Christians about our bodies and our image based on the theology of the resurrection?
5. How can you personally live in the freedom that the resurrection gives us to enjoy the good physical world God made and not ultimately to fear death?
6. In what way does the bodily resurrection also remind us and encourage us to live morally according to God's standards?
