

## **Community Group Questions**

Read the verses: Matthew 27-28

1. It's interesting to me that no one really questions the documented history about how Jesus died on a cross, but there are many who struggle to believe the documented history of how Jesus rose from the dead.

Even when secular historians approach the Bible only as a historical document, almost all accept these three things as facts.

- 1) Jesus was killed by crucifixion under Pontius Pilate;
- 2) His disciples believed they saw the resurrected Jesus and
- 3) The tomb where Jesus was buried was empty.
- 2. What evidence does Matthew give us for the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus? (Additional eyewitness testimony in Acts 1:3, Mark 16, Luke 24, John 20, Acts 1, and 1 Corinthians 15)
- 3. What do you think caused the disciples to desert Jesus (6:56) and Peter to deny Jesus (26:69-75)? What do you think the women were afraid of when they went to the tomb of Jesus on that Sunday morning (28:1-4)?)
- 4. What does Matthew record as the very first message of the Resurrection Story? (28:5-10) Why is that significant?
- 5. When you read the Book of Acts, what is contrast do you see in the lives of the disciples before the resurrection of Jesus and after?
- 6. Why do we need that same message today? What are your top fears?
- 7. How can the Resurrection of Jesus and the message of the Gospel help you let go of your fears?
