When: Sunday June 7, 2020

Sunday Morning 10am- Worship Service Only

What to expect:

While we cannot guarantee the health and safety of those who attend we are taking as many precautions as we possibly can. Our goal is not to turn any healthy person away.

Anyone who is currently sick, has underlying health concerns, or doesn't feel safe or comfortable should continue to stay home and view the service online*.

Seating will be staggered as much as possible. Families are encouraged to sit together. Ushers will not seat anyone next to, directly in front of, or directly behind anyone. Example: If family "A" is seated in row 1 on the left side, family "B" can be seated in row 2 on the right side.

Hand Sanitizer will be made available throughout the building. Extra cleaning measurers will be taken after each service. If the CDC's regulations for wearing masks in public buildings are still in place we will comply.

There will be no fellowship greetings. Microphones will not be used during testimony time. Only the ushers will be handing the offering plates and pre-packaged communion will be used to celebrate the Lord's Supper.

Our goal is to offer a safe yet worshipful experience to all; both those who attend in person and those who watch online*.

All bible studies, leadership meetings, and other church business will continue to be conducted virtually using the zoom platform.
