I Thess 1: 1-10

- Last week we ended our study of Philippians
  - The church at Philippi was established on Paul's second missionary journey
  - Leaving Philippi, Paul and Silas now go to Thessalonica
- Acts 17: 1-10
  - In Thessalonica Paul stays for a short time
  - Yet a church is established there
  - And now about 1 year later Paul writes them this letter
  - This is the first epistle Paul wrote
  - Apparently only stayed there for 3 weeks? (Vs 2)

- A little background of Thessalonica
  - Founded around 326 B.C.
  - It was the largest city of Asia Minor
  - Crime was rampant in the city
    - Many homes built with no windows
    - Female children abandoned all over the city
    - Prostitution was a main industry
    - Murder was an everyday occurrence
- •I Thess 1: 1-10
  - In this passage are a number of points we will study

- Here is a listing.....
- Vs 3
  - Work of faith
  - Labor of love
  - Steadfastness/patience of hope
- Vs 5.....our gospel came
  - In power
  - In the Holy Spirit
  - With full conviction

- Vs 6.....imitators of us
  - With tribulation and joy
  - You became an example (Vs 7)
- Vs 8.....the Word of the Lord
  - Sounded forth from you
  - Your faith has gone forth....everywhere
- Vs 9.....you turned to God
  - From idols
  - To serve a living and true God

- Vs 10.....to wait
  - For the return of Jesus Christ
  - Who was raised from the dead
  - That is Jesus
    - Who rescues us
    - From the wrath to come
- Today we are going to focus on Vs 1-3
  - Vs 1...the greeting of Paul
    - Grace and peace
    - Every letter of Paul begins and ends with a mention of one or both

- Vs 2....we give thanks for all of you
  - Paul was only in Thessalonica 3 weeks
  - Making mention of you in our prayers
    - In this verse, we see the importance of praying for one another
    - Note the word "always" in Vs 2
    - As the Holy Spirit brings people to your mind
      - Lift them up to the Lord
      - I Cor 12: 13-18; 26-27

- As a side note
  - Note the comparison to I Cor 13...
    - Faith, hope and love
    - Here is the listing...faith, love and hope
- Vs 3....work of faith
  - In the realm of faith there are two aspects
    - One aspect is..... trust
    - The other aspect is...... distrust
  - Prov 3: 5-6
    - Trust in the Lord.....
  - Psa 56: 8-11; Psa 13: 5; Psa 40: 4-8; Jer 17: 5-8

- The second aspect is distrust
  - You should follow your heart????
  - Jer 17: 9-10, Prov 14: 30;
    - James 3: 16; Luke 6: 45; Isa 65: 13-14
  - Prov 4: 20-27; Prov 27: 19; Ezek 36: 26; Prov 3: 3-4;
    Psa 42: 5-11
    - Every time we trust in our heart/feelings
      - The result is depression and sorrow
    - Every time we trust in God
      - The result is hope

- Note Vs 3...the work of faith
  - Faith is the hand that grasps the hand of God
  - Faith/trust is the channel of the life of grace
    - It is through grace that we received the life of Christ
  - Faith is the door of the Holy Spirit from above
    - Showing us, all the goodness God has in store for us
  - Faith is the opening of the sunshine of God's love
    - If we do not have faith in God
    - We have nothing in our lives of value

- Labor of love....
  - No one can love God unless they believe that God loves them
    - Just as they are at this present time
  - The love of God is the soul satisfying need your heart is yearning for
    - It is the love of God which will melt the frozen condition of our hearts which is brought on by the selfishness of sin.
    - "Did God really say???"
    - Satan's favorite lie yet today is this one....

- The third foundational stone is "hope"
  - Hope is always directed to the future
  - When faith arises and love is manifested in our hearts
- Then is realized in our hearts the glories of what God has in store for those who trust in Him
  - Rev 22: 1-7
  - Faith, love and hope.....the foundation of living

- I approach the throne of glory Nothing in my hands I bring But the promise of acceptance From a good and gracious King
- •I will give to You my burden As You give to me Your strength Come and fill me with Your Spirit As I sing to You this praise
