Phil 1: 9-11

- •While there are many themes in N.T.....
  - There is an overlying aspect
  - That is "growth"
    - Spiritual growth
- •Note the following....
  - II Peter 1: 5-10
    - "applying all diligence"
    - NIV...."make every effort to add to your faith"
    - 9 things mentioned

- It is not a coincidence the fruit of the Spirit
  - Lists 9 characteristics of "fruit" (Gal 5: 22-23)
  - It also not a coincidence that Phil 1: 9-11
    - Starts out with "love"
  - Then listing the following in sequence
    - "may abound"
    - "real knowledge"
    - "discernment"
    - "sincerity"
    - "blameless"

- •This sequence reminds of Vs 6....He that hath..
  - Will "perfect" it or "mature" it or "complete" it
  - Reiterated in Eph 1: 15-17
  - Reiterated again in Col 1: 9-12
- Paul starts out this passage with....."this I pray"
  - It is insightful that Paul does not pray for material things
  - Rather his concern is for spiritual growth

- •Vs 9....spiritual growth starts with "love"
  - The Greek word here is "agape"
  - The love that comes from God (Gal 5: 22)
- Paul is laying out the foundation of Christian living
  - I Cor 13: 1....if I have not love....
  - •I Cor 13: 13...the greatest of these is.....
  - Col 3: 14.....bond of unity
  - John 13: 35....they will know that.....

#### •Questions....

- Why is Paul praying "that your love abound?"
- Can such love come from within ourselves?
- Can such love come only from the Holy Spirit?
- If the answer is "Yes" how does that love differ from human love?
  - It is not based on emotions, feelings or appearances
- Rom 5: 1-5
  - Because the love of God "has been poured out"
  - "Within our hearts"

- Essential that we understand
  - The love of God is an act of His will
  - John 3: 16-17
  - It is the love of choice
    - It has a two-fold aspect in our lives
    - I choose not to do such and such because of the love of God
    - I choose to do such and such because of the love of God
- When Jesus was asked which is the greatest commandment
  - What was His answer....

- •Love God with all your heart.....
  - What will happen when that takes place?
- •And then you will love your neighbor.....
  - Does that incorporate feelings?
  - Parable of the good Samaritan (Luke 10: 30-37)
  - Not necessarily.....but....(Vs 33)
  - But it might mean you do all you can to meet their need (Vs 35)
- •Vs 9.....still more and more

- •This is the on-going process of growth
  - Eph 3: 14-21; 4: 20-24; 30-32; 5: 1-5
- •The love of God is defined in our lives
  - By our adherence to the Word of God
  - Never will you find an exception
    - If you love Me....you will keep My commandments
    - James 1: 22-25
    - I Peter 1: 22-23

•Biblical love is not wishy-washy or lukewarm

- Biblical love....
  - Flees from sin
  - Flees from that which is wrong
  - Focuses on that which only build others up
    - Phil 4: 8
- •Vs 10.....so you may approve the things that are excellent
  - •No guess work.....
  - The roadmap of joy in Christ

- •I approach the throne of glory Nothing in my hands I bring But the promise of acceptance From a good and gracious King
- •I will give to You my burden As You give to me Your strength Come and fill me with Your Spirit As I sing to You this praise

- •You deserve the greater glory Overcome, I lift my voice To the King in need of nothing Empty handed I rejoice
- You deserve the greater glory Overcome with joy I sing By Your love I am accepted You're a good and gracious King

- •O what grace that You would see me As Your child and as Your friend Safe, secure in You forever I pour out my praise again
- •You deserve the greater glory Overcome, I lift my voice To the King in need of nothing Empty handed I rejoice
