Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV 28 He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV The end goal: present everyone fully mature in Christ

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV The process: proclaim, admonish, teach

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV Proclaim Christ is Lord and make Him the center of your life.

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV Teach and bring up followers of Christ in the knowledge of the wisdom of the Spirit and Word of God.

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV Admonish the lost in love.

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV 29 To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me. 2:1 I want you to know how hard I am contending for you and for those at Laodicea, and for all who have not met me personally.

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV Twice Paul stresses the amount of effort he is putting forth on behalf of Christ for the sake of the Church.

Are we strenuously contending for one another?

Colossians 1:24-2:5 NIV 2 My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, 3 in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. 4 I tell you this so that no one may deceive you by fine-sounding arguments. 5 For though I am absent from you in body, I am present with you in spirit and delight to see how disciplined you are and how firm your faith in Christ is.
