"King" Abimelech



- Using 70 shekels of silver, he bought followers.
- Used followers to help kill his 70 brothers.
- Became King.
- Used power to fight other Israelites to ensure he continued to be king.
- Lasted 3 years before he was killed.

1 Samuel 8:6-9



But when they said, "Give us a king to lead us," this displeased Samuel; so he prayed to the Lord. And the Lord told him: "Listen to all that the people are saying to you; it is not you they have rejected, but they have rejected me as their king. As they have done from the day I brought them up out of Egypt until this day, forsaking me and serving other gods, so they are doing to you. Now listen to them; but warn them solemnly and let them know what the king who will reign over them will claim as his rights."

King Saul



- Chosen by God
- Defeated the Amalekites
- Began as a spiritual leader for Israelites.
- Blatantly disobeyed God, and God rejected him for it.
- Saul sought for David to be destroyed so he would remain king.

King David



- Chosen by God
- "Man after God's own heart."
- Great king, but with several moral failures.
- Sought forgiveness for mistakes and was not rejected by God.
- Passed the title of king to his son, Solomon.

King Solomon



- Sought wisdom from God and was well know for being wise.
- Took an Egyptian wife (1 of 700), which lead to problems later.
- King Solomon eventually allowed for different methods and customs of worship to occur within Israel.

Daniel 7:13-14



"In my vision at night I looked, and there before me was one like a son of man, coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days and was led into his presence. He was given authority, glory and sovereign power; all nations and peoples of every language worshiped him. The Power of King Jesus

Luke 1:35, The angel answered, "The Holy Spirit will come on you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God."

The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Lord, save us! We're going to drown!" He replied, "You of little faith, why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and rebuked the winds and the waves, and it was completely calm. The men were amazed and asked, "What kind of man is this? Even the winds and the waves obey him!"

Ephesians 1:20-21 "he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms, far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every name that is invoked, not only in the present age but also in the one to come."

John 18:36, Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."

1 Timothy 6:13-15, "In the sight of God, who gives life to everything, and of Christ Jesus, who while testifying before Pontius Pilate made the good confession, I charge you to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in his own time—God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords,"
