Scripture: Romans 6:1-11; Romans 6:23; Matthew 6:33; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Galatians 5:22-23

Big Idea: Living a righteous life demands we first die to our old way of living. This pursuit is a daily decision and commitment to saying no to the things we should say no to, and saying yes to the things we should say yes to. The more the old dies, the more we come alive to the new things God wants to do in and through us. The life of a Christian is not a sprint, it is a marathon. It takes sacrificial pursuit.

Think: We have to be thinking about the things of God during the pursuit of righteousness. There will be things everywhere we turn that will try to get us off course.

Feel: Feel the requirement it takes to run a marathon in our walk with Christ. It's a consistent decision of "yes" to the things of God.

Do: Learn what it means to sacrificially pursue Christ. Get into a rhythm of making the decision to follow Christ in every given moment.
