## THE 4 CUPS OF PASSOVER

- 01 **The First Cup – The Cup of Sanctification**  
“I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.”  
**Luke 22:14-18**
- 02 **The Second Cup – Cup of Deliverance** (We don't drink this cup) We recite the plagues and “empty the wrath of God” “I will deliver you from their bondage.”
- 03 **The Third Cup – the Cup of Redemption**  
“I will also redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgment.”  
  
Jesus took this cup and said “Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament (new covenant) in my blood, which is shed for you.” **Luke 22:20 / Jer 31:31-33**
- 04 **The Fourth Cup – The Cup of Praise**  
“Then I will take you for My people, and I will be your God.” Connected with the Fourth Cup is the reciting of Hallel Psalms (praise and thanks **Psalms 115-118**) and the Great Hallel (**Psalm 136**). “And when they had sung an hymn, they went out into the mount of Olives.” (**Mark 14:26**)

1. *If He brought us out of  
Egypt, yet had not judged  
the Egyptians (DAYENU)*

2. *If He had judged the  
Egyptians, yet had not  
judged their false gods  
(DAYENU)*

3. *Had He brought us out of  
Egypt, but not split the sea  
before us only brought us  
out of Egypt (DAYENU)*

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## SEDER MEAL

Seder means order - the meal and ceremony follow a very precise order to remember the freedom from Egypt, it is a shadow of the freedom we can obtain through Jesus and his sacrifice, as He is our perfect Passover Lamb.

## HAGGADAH

Guide for the Seder. Haggadah means “to tell”, in Exodus it says that we should tell our children about the Lord's deliverance from slavery. **“when thy son asketh thee”**

## LET'S PREPARE - THROW AWAY THE LEAVEN

"Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump? **Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:** therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

## Symbols of Passover Seder



**egg**  
An egg stands for a special offering Jews made on holidays.

**horseradish**  
A bitter plant reminds Jews of the hard times in Egypt.

**lamb bone**  
The Jews killed a lamb when they left Egypt.

**sweet paste**  
This fruit and nut mix symbolizes the mortar the Jews used to build pyramids.

**parsley**  
A vegetable is dipped in salt water, symbolizing the tears Jews cried as slaves.

**romaine lettuce**  
A second bitter plant serves as another reminder of the hard times in Egypt.

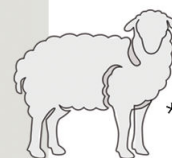
What makes this night different from all other nights?

- 1) On all nights we eat chametz (leaven) or matzah, and on this night only matzah?
- 2) On all nights we eat any kind of vegetables, and on this night maror (bitter herbs)?
- 3) On all nights we need not dip even once, on this night we do so twice?
- 4) On all nights we eat sitting upright or reclining, and on this night we all recline?

## THE LAMB

\* The Father of the house would have a lamb and inspect it for 3 days, and then before slaughtering it would declare it "without fault" (John 19:4)

\* Jesus is the perfect lamb of God that taketh away the sin of the world – (John 1:29)



\* No bones were allowed to be broken (Exo 12:46 / John 19:36)
