Questions for Study and Group Discussion
** Before you begin, please read Galatians 5:22-23

- 1. When you think of faithfulness, who comes to mind that has shown what that looks like? How did they display faithfulness in their life?
- 2. Deut. 32.4, Psalm 33.4-5, and Psalm 36:5 all talk about God's faithfulness. How is God's faithfulness described? What does this teach us about faithfulness and God?
- 3. When has God proved himself faithful in your life? When has it been hard to see or understand God's faithfulness?
- 4. Read Matthew 25.14-23. What does Jesus say to the servants? Why?
- 5. Read Luke 16:10-13. What principle does Luke 16:10 teach? How does this align with grace?
- 6. Read 2 Tim 4:7-8. Paul said this before he was dead. What are you doing now so when you are "old" you can say this?
- 7. What does verse 8 say about Paul's motivation? Why is this a good motivation? Is this a motivator for you?
- 8. **Challenge:** Looking back over the Fruitful Relationship message series, which "fruit" would you like to see more of in your life when it comes to your relationships? Why?
- 9. **Challenge:** Write out Galatians 5:22-23 and then put it somewhere to be encouraged daily. "The fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."
