** Before you begin, please read Matthew 5:13-16

- 1. When is the last time you had a conversation with one of your neighbors? How did it go?
- 2. Does talking with your neighbors come easy or hard for you? Why or why not?
- 3. Imagine you had to summarize the point of the message in 1-2 sentences. What would you say?
- 4. Why is this message important to hear?
- 5. Re-read the passage that was read during the message. What stands out to you or do you want to discuss, from this truth in God's Word?
- 6. What was your biggest take-away from the message? Why?
- 7. What questions did the message create for you, that you want to bring up and talk more about?
- 8. Imagine your life in light of what you read and heard in the message:
 - What would your life look like, living in line with what you've learned from God's Word?
 - What are the biggest challenges you anticipate, as you think about living in line with what you've learned?
 - Is there a specific situation in your life right now, where truth from this passage shapes how you live / think / relate with others?
 - What is one way you can practically apply what you learned this week?
- 9. Close in prayer. How does this passage prompt you to pray? What else can your group be praying about for you?
