

Difference Maker: Moses April 16, 2023

Exodus 4:1-17

Questions for Study and Group Discussion
** Before you begin, please read Exodus 4:1-17

- 1. When you think of making a difference in the lives of others, what comes to mind?
- 2. Describe someone who God has used to make a difference in your life. What about this person made them a "difference maker" in your life?
- 3. Read Exodus 3:7-10. What is God asking Moses to do?
- 4. How does Moses respond to God's command? (Hint: Look especially at Exodus 4:1, 4:10, and 4:13. See also Moses' initial response in Exodus 3:11.)
- 5. In Exodus 4, Moses is 80 years old (see Exodus 7:7). He has a messy past, and he has been living as a shepherd for the prior decades (If it's helpful, spend a few minutes reviewing Moses's past in Exodus 1-3 as a group.) How do you think these realities affected the way Moses heard and responded to God's command?
- 6. What does God tell Moses, that overpowers Moses's excuses?
- 7. How does focusing on the presence and power of God change the way we approach our excuses?
- 8. Spend time as a group creating a list of excuses that people may think of, that keeps them from believing God can make a difference through them.
- 9. Do any of these excuses "strike home" for you personally?
- 10. How does knowing God's presence and power change the way you approach this excuse?
- 11. How have you seen your life / actions make a difference in the lives of others, in a way that serves them and honors God? (Don't just feel like you need to think about "big things"! Consider the small ways you make a difference as well.)
- 12. Why is it important for followers of Jesus to see themselves as difference makers? (Read 1 Corinthians 12:12-27 and Ephesians 4:11-12.)
- 13. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? Why did this stand out to you the way it did?
