

The Church Responds to Jesus in Worship July 9, 2023 Revelation 4-5

Questions for Study and Group Discussion

- ** Before you begin, please read Revelation 4-5. As you read, remember apocalyptic literature is supposed to evoke your imagination. Really try to picture in your mind what is happening in these 2 chapters.
- 1. As you read these two chapters in Revelation, what kind of emotions did it draw out of you?
- 2. If someone was to ask you why you worship God, what would you say?
- 3. What are your observations on the throne room scene in chapter 4. What did God look like? What does His appearance say about His character?
- 4. Who are the 24 elders and what do they represent?
- 5. The 24 elders "cast their crowns before the throne". What is the purpose of a crown (see 2 Tim 4:8)? What does the action of casting their crowns before the throne symbolize?
- 6. Who are the 4 creatures and what do they represent? What do you notice about their worship in verse 8?
- 7. After reading chapter 4 and walking through the questions above, what is John's purpose in writing this description? What is your response to chapter 4?
- 8. Chapter 5 starts with a focus on the scroll. What is in the scroll? Why is John weeping?
- 9. In verses 5-6 we get a beautiful mixed metaphor about Jesus. What does it mean that He is the Lion-Lamb? What does this name say about how He has victory?
- 10. The 24 elders and 4 creatures who were worshiping God the Father, now turn their worship to Jesus. What does this say about who Jesus is?
- 11. Read Revelation 5:11-14. What do you notice about the worship that is taking place? Does your worship reflect this kind of worship?
- 12. Read again Revelation 5:9. What does it mean that we are His kingdom and His priests?
- 13. How can you serve God and bring forth His Kingdom?
- 14. As priests, how can you worship Him as He deserves in your everyday life?
