



Who Are You Becoming?
February 25, 2024 | Selected Scripture
Questions for Study and Group Discussion

1. Icebreaker: Think back to goals, interests, or hobbies you had as a child. What is different about you today? How have you changed from your pre-teen years?
2. Why is it important to think intentionally about the question, “who are you becoming?”
3. Read the following passages of Scripture: Galatians 4:19; 1 John 2:6; 1 John 4:17. Based on what you read in these verses, who should we be becoming more like as disciples of Jesus Christ?
4. Why is it important to have clarity on the goal of discipleship? What happens if there’s fuzziness about this goal instead?
5. “Building blocks” toward this goal include 6Cs that are firmly rooted in the Bible and practically helpful. The first three Cs are listed below. Read the Scripture that follows each “C,” then briefly define what each “C” is getting at in your own words.
 - Commitment to Jesus: Luke 9:23-25; Romans 10:9-10; see also Matthew 6:19-22, 24
 - Communion with God: John 17:3; Philippians 3:7-8; see also Matthew 7:21-23
 - Community with others: 1 Corinthians 12:12-14; Hebrews 10:24-25; 1 John 4:11 -12
6. Are there any other verses from Scripture that come to mind, that further reinforce any of these three “Cs”? If so, spend some time looking them up and sharing them as a group.
7. Have any of these three Cs listed above been especially important in your own growth in Christlikeness? Explain.
8. Which of these three Cs has received the least attention in your own life? Why do you think that’s the case?
9. Imagine what your life could look like three months from now as you live in light of these three Cs. What change(s) would stand out most noticeably to those who know you best?
10. What other questions or comments do you have about what you’ve looked at in the Bible today?
11. What is your biggest take-away from what you’ve discussed so far? What practical step will you take to apply what you’ve seen in God’s Word?
12. **Challenge:** Identify one way the truths you’ve discussed are challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you’re learning this coming week?
13. **Challenge: Memorize 1 John 2:6:** Whoever claims to live in Him must live as Jesus did.
