

God, an Ever-Present Help July 21, 2024 | Psalm 46 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

** Before you begin, please read Psalm 46

- 1. In what ways does it feel to you like our world is being turned upside-down right now?
- 2. Observe how God is described in verse 1 and then define what each of those three descriptions mean.
- 3. Observe how the world is described in verses 2-3. What is your impression of the picture of the world that is given in those verses?
- 4. In verse 2, the psalmist declares that we will not fear. On what basis does the psalmist make this claim?
- 5. Compare the description of the city of God in verses 4-5 with the description of the world in verses 2-3. What is the difference between the two?
- 6. What are some of the works of the Lord described in the Bible in which God delivers His people from enemies?
- 7. Yet why do we often doubt what this psalm teaches us about God?
- 8. What are some of the things you have sometimes wrongly taken refuge in other than God?
- 9. In what ways can you specifically take refuge in God right now? Who do you know and trust that can help you do this?
- 10. In what way is Jesus the fulfillment of this psalm? How is He our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble? (If time allows, you might find it helpful to read something like John 11.)
- 11. **Challenge: Memorize Psalm 46:1** "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."
