**Questions for Study and Group Discussion**

*\*\* Before you begin, please read Matthew 6:19-34*

1. How does this passage illuminate that our priorities are so important we need to fight to hold things in the correct order?
2. Read Matthew 6:19-21. Why do you think Jesus is teaching on treasure?
3. What kind of treasure is stored in heaven? What are the treasures you are holding onto here on earth?
4. In verse 24, why does Jesus start broadly saying, "No one can serve two masters", but by the end of the passage, He says, "You cannot serve God and money"?
5. Verse 25 begins with "Therefore", which ties it in with the previous passage. How does Jesus use verses 19-24 to prepare the reader for verses 25-34?
6. Jesus is teaching on being anxious. How would this passage fit in with our conversation regarding anxiety in 2024? Does it even come into play?
7. Read Matthew 6:33 again. What are you seeking first: God or something else?
8. Why do we humans have such a hard time making God's Kingdom first in our desires when it is such a simple, seemingly easy, command?
9. Read Matthew 6:34. What does Jesus mean by this verse?
10. How does storing treasures in heaven and not being anxious challenge us to grow more like Christ?
- 11. Challenge: Think of the steps you need to take to make sure your top priority is God-worshipping, serving, spending time with Him, etc.**
