

Hope in God's Promises December 3, 2023 | Genesis 3:1-15 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

**Before discussing these questions, read through Genesis 3:1-15 as a group.

- 1. Icebreaker: Why is correctly diagnosing an illness essential for reaching an effective cure? (Or think of it this way: How can misdiagnosing an illness create more problems than it solves?)
- 2. In a word or short phrase, what is the biblical diagnosis for what's wrong in humanity based on what you read in Genesis 3:1-15?
- 3. What else do you learn in Genesis 3:1-15 about the nature and seriousness of sin? Make a short list of 5-7 observations from this passage of Scripture.
- 4. Create a short list of alternative suggestions for "what's wrong with the world" according to the culture around us. Compare / contrast these alternative suggestions with the biblical diagnosis.
- 5. Now focus on Genesis 3:15. To whom is this promise ultimately pointing?
- 6. Read the following passages. After each, share what it adds to how Jesus defeats sin and/or the works of the devil.
 - Romans 5:6-11
 - 2 Corinthians 5:21
 - Hebrews 2:14-15
- 7. How can the truths you've discovered shape the way you approach Christmas this year? How should these truths guide your thoughts? Actions? Emotions?
- 8. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible?
- 9. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? What practical step will you take to apply what you've seen in God's Word?
- 10. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
