

## How Do I Know Jesus Can Forgive My Sin? September 17, 2023 Mark 2:1-12

## **Questions for Study and Group Discussion**

\*\* Before you begin, please read Mark 2:1-12

- 1. Describe a recent time when you had to overcome an obstacle to arrive at a goal. What was the goal? What was the obstacle? How did it turn out?
- 2. In Mark 2:3-4, what is the goal of the men (the paralytic man and his friends)? What obstacle did they hit?
- 3. How did these men respond to the obstacle they faced? What stands out to you about this?
- 4. What motivated these men to overcome the obstacle / inconvenience of getting to Jesus?
- 5. Look closely at the passage and make a list of the different ways people respond to Jesus throughout Mark 2:1-12.
- 6. Do any of these responses match the way you respond to Jesus? Explain.
- 7. In this story we learn that Jesus doesn't only have the power to heal physically, He has the power to heal spiritually (forgiveness). Why do we need forgiveness so desperately? (Hint: see Rom 3:23; Rom 6:23.)
- 8. How does what you learn about Jesus in this passage motivate you to approach him?
- 9. What obstacles or inconveniences do you face in "getting to Jesus"?
- 10. How can the identity of Jesus motivate you to overcome these obstacles?
- 11. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? Why?
- 12. What practical step will you take to apply what you've seen in God's Word?
- 13. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
- 14. **Challenge:** Memorize 1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
