- 1. Read Ruth 1:1-5. Have you ever experienced the loss of a close loved one? How did God show Himself to you during that time?
- **2**. Read Ruth 1:11-13. Why do you think Ruth wanted her daughters-in-law to stay in Moab when she left?
- **3**. How do you think you would respond if you were in Naomi's position? What if you were in Ruth's position?
- 4. Why do you think Ruth was so set on going with Naomi back to Israel?
- 5. Read Ruth 1:20-21. What does this tell us about Naomi's view of God in suffering? What is your view of God in suffering?
- 6. When have you felt full? Empty? Why?
- 7. How is God related to the events of your life? Does He seem close or distant?
- 8. What can this passage teach you about loss and your Christian community?
- **9**. How does this chapter reflect the overarching narrative of God's redemption that is intertwined throughout the Bible?
- 10. **Challenge:** Think about opportunities you are given to come alongside someone who is suffering. What will you do to encourage and love them during the suffering?
