Questions for Study and Group Discussion

*** Before you begin, please read Daniel 3:1-30*

1. Icebreaker: In your own words, how would you define courage?
2. What examples of courage come to mind, when you think about this virtue?
3. Make a list of ways you see courage on display in Daniel 3:1-30.
4. Focus on Daniel 3:16-18. From what you read in these verses, what beliefs motivate the display of courage we see here? Explain.
5. How does a big view of God motivate bold displays of godly courage? (See also Acts 4:29.)
6. How can you cultivate a big, right view of God in your life?
7. Daniel 3 shows us not only God's greatness — it also shows us His presence (see Dan 3:25.) How does trust in the presence of God motivate courage?
8. Is there an area where the circumstances in your life feel bigger than God? How might the truth of God's greatness and the reality of His presence affect your view of these circumstances?
9. What step of godly courage do you need to take in your life, based on what you've learned from Daniel 3?
10. What other questions or comments do you have about what you've looked at in the Bible today?
11. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? What practical step will you take to apply what you've seen in God's Word?
12. **Challenge:** Identify one way this passage is challenging or encouraging you. Who can you tell about what you're learning this coming week?
13. **Challenge – Memorize Joshua 1:9:** 9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."
