Questions for Study and Group Discussion

*** Before you begin, please read 2 Corinthians 5:14-21*

1. One of Brookside’s core values is “Intentional Relationships” — we love genuinely and share Christ boldly. Spend some time as a group summarizing what each half of that statement means, in your own words.
2. Why is this value of Intentional Relationships so important?
3. From 2 Corinthians 5:14-21, what motivated Paul? Why do you think this was so compelling to him?
4. From what you read in 2 Corinthians 5, how did this motivation lead Paul to think and act differently?
5. How does this love of Christ “compel us” (2 Corinthians 5:14) to tell others about Him?
6. Read Luke 10:25-37. What connecting points do you see between this passage and what you read in 2 Corinthians 5:14-21?
7. Brookside is in a special season called our “Compelled to Care” initiative. How does what you’ve learned in 2 Corinthians 5:14-21 help set the tone for this initiative?
8. What truths about Christ’s love do you need to keep in mind as motivation?
9. What practical steps can you take this week to “love genuinely and share Christ boldly”?
10. What other questions or comments do you have about this passage that haven’t yet come up and that you’d like to discuss?
11. What’s your biggest take-away from the passage(s) you’ve looked at and this time discussing as a group?
