- 3. From 2 Corinthians 5:14-21, what motivated Paul? Why do you think this was so compelling to him?
- 4. From what you read in 2 Corinthians 5, how did this motivation lead Paul to think and act differently?
- 5. How does this love of Christ "compel us" (2 Corinthians 5:14) to tell others about Him?
- 6. Read Luke 10:25-37. What connecting points do you see between this passage and what you read in 2 Corinthians 5:14-21?
- 7. Brookside is in a special season called our "Compelled to Care" initiative. How does what you've learned in 2 Corinthians 5:14-21 help set the tone for this initiative?
- 8. What truths about Christ's love do you need to keep in mind as motivation?
- 9. What practical steps can you take this week to "love genuinely and share Christ boldly"?
- 10. What other questions or comments do you have about this passage that haven't yet come up and that you'd like to discuss?
- 11. What's your biggest take-away from the passage(s) you've looked at and this time discussing as a group?
