Questions for Study and Group Discussion
** Before you begin, please read Revelation 2:8-11

- 1. Can you share about a time in your life when you were going through a difficult situation, and you saw God working in your favor?
- 2. Jesus introduces Himself in verse 8 as the one who died and came to life again. How does that give you hope today as a follower of Christ?
- 3. We see in verse 9 that Smyrna is a church marked by affliction, poverty, and persecution. In your personal life, how do you normally respond when you find yourself in difficulty?
- 4. In verse 10 the church of Smyrna is commanded by Jesus not to fear, how can that become a reality in the life of every believer? What verses in the Bible do you remember about living without fear?
- 5. The church of Smyrna suffered persecution because of their faith in Jesus. How is the church of Jesus still being persecuted today in America and the rest of the world?
- 6. We also see in verse 10 that we are encouraged to be faithful even amid afflictions. How is that a possibility in the life of an ordinary follower of Jesus?
- 7. What are some everyday examples of areas in your life where you are challenged with the choice of either denying or following Jesus?
- 8. What is your biggest take-away from what you've discussed so far? Why did this stand out to you the way it did?
- 9. **Challenge: Memorize Revelation 2:10b** "Be faithful, even to the point of death and I will give you the crown of life."
