

Christmas Eve December 24, 2023 | Luke 2:1-38 Questions for Study and Group Discussion

**Before discussing these questions, read through Luke 2:1-38 as a group.

- 1. Icebreaker: Imagine you were asked by a friend what the true significance of Christmas is. What would you say?
- 2. How would you summarize the point of the message that was taught in 1-2 sentences?
- 3. Why is this message important to hear?
- 4. What stands out to you or do you want to discuss, from the truth you read in God's Word?
- 5. What was your biggest take-away from the Bible passage and/or the message? Why?
- 6. What questions did the message create for you, that you want to bring up and talk more about?
- 7. Reflect on your response to Question #1. Is there any way(s) you'd add to your answer, based on what you've learned from the Bible?
- 8. Imagine your life in light of what you read and heard in the message:
 - What would your life look like, living in line with what you've learned from God's Word?
 - What are the biggest challenges you anticipate, as you think about living in line with what you've learned?
 - Is there a specific situation in your life right now, where truth from this passage shapes how you live, think or relate with others?
 - What is one way you can practically apply what you learned this week?
- 9. Close in prayer. How does this passage prompt you to pray? What else can your group be praying about for you?
