DEATH COULD NOT DEFEAT HIM

- ◆ **[Mat 21:1-4 NASB20]** 1 When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, Jesus then sent two disciples,
- ◆ 2 saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied [there] and a colt with it. Untie them and bring them to Me.
- ◆ 3 "And if anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord needs them,' and he will send them on immediately."
- ◆ 4 Now this took place so that what was spoken through the prophet would be fulfilled:

- ◆ **[Mat 21:5-8 NASB20]** 5 "SAY TO THE DAUGHTER OF ZION, 'BEHOLD YOUR KING IS COMING TO YOU, HUMBLE, AND MOUNTED ON A DONKEY, EVEN ON A COLT, THE FOAL OF A DONKEY.'" "
- ◆ 6 The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them,
- ◆ 7 and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their cloaks on them; and He sat on the cloaks.
- ◆ 8 Most of the crowd spread their cloaks on the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them on the road.

- ◆ **[Mat 21:9-11 NASB20]** 9 Now the crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting, "Hosanna to the Son of David; BLESSED IS THE ONE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Hosanna in the highest!"
- ◆ 10 When He had entered Jerusalem, all the city was stirred, saying, "Who is this?"
- ◆ 11 And the crowds were saying, "This is Jesus the prophet, from Nazareth in Galilee."

Unstoppable Authority

- ◆ **[Col 1:16-17 NASB20]** 16 for by Him all things were created, [both] in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, or dominions, or rulers, or authorities--all things have been created through Him and for Him. 17 He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together.
- ◆ **[Mat 28:18 NASB20]** 18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me.

His Authority is Recognized

- ◇ **[Luk 19:38-40 NASB20]** 38 shouting: "BLESSED IS the King, THE ONE WHO COMES IN THE NAME OF THE LORD; Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"
- ◇ 39 And [yet] some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to Him, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples!"
- ◇ 40 Jesus replied, "I tell you, if these stop speaking, **the stones will cry out!**"



Palm Sunday – The King Has Come

His Authority Looks Different

- ◆ **[Zec 9:9 NASB20]** 9 Rejoice greatly, daughter of Zion! Shout [in triumph,] daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; He is righteous and endowed with salvation, Humble, and mounted on a donkey, Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

THE PROPHECIES OF MESSIAH

- ✓ Born in Bethlehem *Micah 5:2*
- ✓ Crucified for Our Sins *Isaiah 53*
- ✓ Rides a Donkey into Jerusalem *Zechariah 9:9*

CHANCE OF ONE PERSON FULFILLING 8 PROPHECIES:

1 IN 10¹⁷

A 1 IN 100 QUADRILLION CHANCE!



His Authority Was Proven

- ◇ **[Jhn 19:10-11 NASB20]** 10 So Pilate said to Him, "Are you not speaking to me? Do You not know that I have authority to release You, and I have authority to crucify You?"
- ◇ 11 Jesus answered him, "You would have no authority over Me at all, if it had not been given to you from above; for this reason the one who handed Me over to you has [the] greater sin."
- ◇ **[Jhn 10:18 NASB20]** 18 "No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it back. This commandment I received from My Father."

◇ **[Col 2:15 NASB20]** 15 When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities, He made a public display [of them,] having triumphed over them through Him.

His Authority Now Demands Surrender

- ◇ **[Phl 2:10-11 NASB20]** 10 so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and [that] every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.





Jesus does not have to wrestle with chaos.
He speaks, and chaos has to bow.

Storm → *“Peace, be still.”*

Demons → *“Come out.”*

Death → *“Come forth.”*

“When Jesus speaks, His authority is already in His word.”
