• We may do something in late June like another potluck picnic in the park. Let us know your thoughts promptly for consideration.





## **Food Pantry News**

During the February Food Pantry distribution we were able to handout 62 bags. Those bags went to 44 households which totaled 133 people - 33 were children, 65 adults, and 35 were seniors. That would comes out to 29 families of 1-3 members, 12 families of 4- 6, and 3 families of 7+. For this distribution we had 10 new people.

The Food Pantry team wishes to THANK all the groups of the church that use the church freezer for allowing the Food Pantry to use the lower level of the church freezer to acquire more frozen meat, which allows us to continue to distribute the normal volume - even as we have more persons coming to the First UMC Fox Hill Food Pantry for assistance
