

Disaffiliation Information Session: Sunday, March 5, 2pm.

We'll watch a couple of brief videos outlining reasons for and against, talk about what disaffiliation is and how the process works, answer questions as best we can, and talk about our future as a congregation. No one is required to attend, but anyone who wants information and a chance to gain clarity about what any action could mean for our church is invited to come. You'll also receive a handout with references.

Lent

Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, Feb. 22. Ash Wednesday service will be held on Wednesday, Feb 22, 7pm, and will feature the imposition of ashes. Our confirmands burned the palm branches from Palm Sunday and will be helping to impose those ashes. Mark and Patty will bring an inspired word, and we will witness a symbol of the power of God's forgiveness when we light the flash paper near the end of the service. It will be, as always, a time to remember and celebrate.

Prayer Teaching

For two nights, following Ash Wednesday, Pastor Brian, along with Mark and Patty Biondolillo, will hold **Prayer Teaching**. We will share in teaching and leading participants through different prayer disciplines, including intercessory prayer and the prayer of faith (for healing and so forth). Praying the Psalms

Starting next week, **February 26**, we'll start a new series for the season of Lent, "**Praying the Psalms**" While we're familiar with reading, even responsive reading of the Psalms, most of us haven't been exposed to chanting the Psalms (Mark will lead that at the 9am services), much less using the Psalms as a prayer guide. Join us as we turn these ancient words into modern prayers, deepening our lives and widening our spiritual lives so that the line between ancient, modern, secular, and spiritual disappears into the grace of God for all people everywhere.
