#### Final Report on Disaffiliation in the Virginia Annual Conference

On Saturday October 7th, a called Virginia Annual Conference was held to consider the ratification of 120 local churches seeking to disaffiliate from The United Methodist Church over matters of human sexuality using Paragraph 2553 of the Book of Discipline.

These churches represented 5.6% of the membership of the Virginia Annual Conference and 7.36% of the total weekly worshipping population.

In a vote of 92% to 8%, these churches were given approval to continue the process. All disaffiliation action must be completed by December 7th. If this timeline is not met, a church will not be allowed to disaffiliate and keep their property.

The final total for churches disaffiliating in the Virginia Annual Conference since 2019 is 227 churches. These churches represent approximately 20% of all churches in the conference. In addition, they represent 10.58% of the membership of the conference and 14.44% of the total weekly worshipping population. In addition, 71 clergy have withdrawn from the conference.

The Virginia Annual Conference will still have 875 churches and will remain one of the largest annual conferences in the United States.

We now look forward to the General Conference which will be held beginning April 23, 2024 in Charlotte, NC. We will remain hopeful that the division in the United Methodist Church over the human sexuality issue can be resolved at this conference, so we can look forward to a bright future as Christians together.
