Thanks to all who have contributed to our live-stream fund-raising effort to date. We are making progress upgrading the “back row” to accommodate new digital cameras and production equipment, as additional funds come in. We are still in need of another camera and a digital-audio interface. Please remember to earmark your dedicated contributions for A/V or the LUMENS fund.

As an added incentive: Once we have made our initial investment in digital equipment, we will dedicate additional contributions to build a pleasant-looking booth to house the operations center and hide all those unsightly wires which, now and necessarily, are not hidden from view!!!

More importantly, we are in need of new personnel to help flesh-out our extremely small AV production team. It takes four A/V technicians to livestream “on the air” the 8:30 a.m. church service, and we are currently at minimal staffing. Operating positions include: video presentation (slides and video clips), video mixing and camera operation, audio mixing, and live-stream production monitoring. On-job-training is willingly provided. As you know, none of us are professionals — we’re all learning as we go!! So, if you would like to try your hand at live projection — please contact one of the team members.

We are continuing to identify problems with our network connectivity, which seems to be a major problem with 8:30 a.m. service reliability. Hopefully this will be resolved shortly, as Pastor Brian would like to resume live-streaming services, and it seems many of you enjoy that particular service. Thank you for your inquiries, and be assured we are doing our best to resolve problems.
