

Mike Williams, earlier in the week, weighed 189 pounds of product and I am confident that after services on 6/12, when the products were transferred to the Food Pantry Team of First UMC Fox Hill there were much more

As Pastor Brian mentioned during the service, Sunday, June 12, these canned goods will stay at First UMC Fox Hill and be used for our own community outreach mission by the Food Pantry team. He also reported that in these difficult economic times, with rising inflation, our Food Pantry continues to see a significantly higher number of people coming to our distribution dates each month.

We would like to give a BIG thank you to Mike Williams for heading the "Cans for Conference" drive and for taking the time to do inventories and weighing of the products that the congregation so generously donated.
