On Wednesday, April 24 the Food Pantry came close to the record set in September 2023. We served 82 households (including 9 new ones) for a total of 252 people and 122 bags of food. Our previous recorded high in September 2024 was 84 households, 261 people, and 124 bags.

As always, our participants were very grateful and expressed their thanks. We also had a neighbor from the Salt Pond Community that admires what our church is doing to assist families that are food insecure who gave us a monetary donation.

The Food Pantry team continues to be amazed at the generosity of the congregation in filling up the big Red Food Pantry Tub.
