## HIStory: Seeing God's Plan in the Bible

## <u>Creation</u> $\rightarrow$ Sin $\rightarrow$ Flood $\rightarrow$ Promise $\rightarrow$ Christ $\rightarrow$ Eternity

- God, self-existent, wat before all things and will never cease to exist, He created all things

A. Creation week overview

"Created" = shape, form out of nothing
"Let there be" = a verbal command to exist or happen
"Day" = "yom" = Hebrew for a 24-hour period of time
Day 1 - Light, Day and night - 1:2-5
Day 2 - Atmosphere, separated the air from the water - 1:6-8
Day 3 - Dry land and vegetation - 1:9-13
Day 4 - Everything in the expanse of the heavens (space), sun for day, moon for night - 1:14-19
Day 5 - All aquatic creature and bird - 1:20-23
Day 6 - All land animals and mankind - 1:24-31
Day 7 - God rests. This in no way indicates He was weary from His creative efforts; rather, it denotes that the creation is complete. Further, God is establishing a pattern of one day in seven to rest. (Exodus 20:8-11).

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**About God**: God is the Creator of all things, He specifically made mankind.

- Because we are made in God's image, we have the ability to know God and therefore love and worship Him, serve Him and fellowship with Him.

**Big Picture**: God created all in the beginning.

- Everything was created and was called "very good" by God (1:31)

## Application: The Creator

- Colossians 1:16 We were made for Him.
- 1 Corinthians 10:31 We were made to glorify God

\* "Glorify" = reflecting God in all we do so others see Him through us.
