**Follow** – We "follow all kinds of things – Facebook, Instagram, Blogs, etc. – for fun – list different SM sites

- We follow a favorite sports team, political candidate, hobby
- Follow implies that we have a love for something/someone or at the very least an interest in it/them.

## DISCUSSION: What have you chose to learn/become a student of? (Music, Hobbies)

- Example: Rubik Cube, Astronomy (Stars, constellations, meteors)
  - \* As Believers, it's easy to be a "casual" type believer
  - \* God calls us to much more than that, He calls us to be a disciple!

A disciple is another word for a follower of Christ, one who is learning to be like Him.

Disciple = follower, student, learner

# OUR INQURY IS NOT WHAT IS FOLLOWING BUT WHAT A LIFE LOOKS LIKE IF IT IS TRULY FOLLOWING CHRIST?

## The Foundation of being a disciple – a relationship

**1.** Before we can even consider being a disciple of Jesus and follow Him, we must first know Him. Sheep are used as an example.

### Without a Relationship with God

**Isaiah 53:6** - All <u>we like sheep</u> have <u>gone astray</u>; we have <u>turned</u>—every one—<u>to his own way</u>; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

- We have a problem that does not allow us to be followers of Jesus – Sin (iniquity) – In fact, the word "enemy" is used to describe us before we have a relationship with God!

Romans 5:10 - For if while <u>we were enemies</u> we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.

- <u>**Contrast**</u> Isaiah 53:6 with the following. Note the distinct difference in the two passages in light of the Sheep/Shepherd relationship

<u>John 10:3-4, 10, 14</u> – "To him the gatekeeper opens. <u>The sheep hear his voice</u>, and he calls his own sheep by name and <u>leads</u> them out. When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep <u>follow</u> him, for they <u>know</u> his voice." 10 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd <u>lays down his life</u> for the sheep. 14 I am the good shepherd. <u>I know my own</u> and <u>my own know me</u>,

#### Shephard and Sheep Relationship

\*The sheep know and hear Their Shepherd's voice - Familiar with the Shepherd's voice, The Shepherd knows each sheep by name individually

\*The Shepherd leads the sheep and they willingly follow his lead – fully trusted by the sheep and is followed with full confidence

\*The Shepherd will sacrifice His own life for his sheep – The sheep have rest and peace, knowing the Shepherd is protecting them

\*They know each other - "Know" means to understand, get to know, become acquainted with – written in the original language of Greek to be understood to be an ongoing activity!

### 2. How do we get to know the Good Shepherd? - Simple as ABC

- A Acknowledge that I have fallen short of God's perfect standard for life – Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23a
- B Believe that God made a way for forgiveness for our failure and to have a relationship with Him – Romans 5:8, John 3:16, Romans 6:23b Romans 10:9-10
- C Call on Jesus to accept His gift of forgiveness and peace – Romans 10:13
