* God (creation) Adam and Eve, Noah (sin), Abraham, Moses, Israel

A. God shows His power and delivers Israel from bondage in Egypt (Exodus 7-13)

- Plague #10 All firstborns died and was an attack on Pharaoh's "deity" (Exodus 11-13)
 - * Protection for Israel Passover (12:5-7, 13-14)
 - + What were the Israelites to do to be protected from the plague?
 - * God was showing the world a glimpse of hope He would bring for sin in the future.

B. The "Ten" Commands of God Exodus 21:1-17

- You shall have no other gods before me (Exodus 20:3)
- You shall not make for yourself a carved image (Exodus 20:4-6)
- You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain (Exodus 20:7)
- Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy (Exodus 20:8-11)
- -Honor your father and mother. (Exodus 20:12)
- -Thou shalt not murder. (Exodus 20:13)
- -You shalt not commit adultery. (Exodus 20:14)
- -You shalt not steal. (Exodus 20:15)
- -You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. (Exodus 20:16)
- You shall not covet your neighbor's house... or anything that is your neighbor's. (Exodus 20:17)

About God: God showed Himself to be the one true God by defeating the man-made gods of Egypt (the most powerful nation of the time).

Big Picture: God continued to keep His promise to Abraham.

- Israel is now heading toward claiming the land promised to Abraham in order to become the nation that blesses the world with Jesus.

Application: The Ten Commandments are to show us our sin and need for forgiveness which is offered through Jesus' death and resurrection.
