James 1:9-12 – Dealing with tough times in life - pt.2

1. A Biblical Mindset during trials – v. 9-11

a. Example - Rich and poor believers - vv.9-11

- Lowly Brother who is struggling with being poor can still be joyful in His circumstance. (v. 9)

- The rich can be joyful in his humiliation losing wealth or influence (v. 10-11)
- b. Lessons about our mindset during trials
 - All are equal when it comes to trials I'm not alone!
 - Regardless of our situation, we know that as believers we are:
 - + Part of God's family Romans 8:15
 - + Promised that God will provide our needs Matthew 6:33
 - + Trials are temporary. A believer should focus on their eternal hope.
 - * Romans 8:18, Revelation 21:3-4
 - * 2 Corinthians 4:16-18

2. The big picture of trials – v. 12

- a. For those who remain faithful and trust God through trial, they will receive the crown of life.
 - not like a king's crown, a symbol of victory or honor
- b. Romans 8:28-29
 - God works everything for good for His children.
 - His plan includes saving us (when we accept His gift of forgiveness) and making us more like Jesus.
- c. 1 Peter 5:6-10
 - "Humble" = submit to His plan
 - "Casting all your anxieties" = Our first response in trials
 - "Roaring lion" = Satan wants to defeat us in trials
 - "brotherhood throughout the world" = we are not alone!
 - "Restore, confirm, strengthen, establish" = God is with us every step of the way.
