Pharaoh's Daughter - the Princess

Exodus 1:6-2:10, Hebrews 11:23-29

What do we know about the princess from the Bible?

- 1. She was the daughter of one of the most powerful men on earth. (2:5)
- 2. She spared Moses' life even though he should have died. (2:6)
- 3. Because she had great influence in the kingdom, she was able to disobey her father's orders without penalty. (2:7-9)
- 4. Her choice not only spared Moses, it also provided for him and his family for several years. (2:9)

What can we speculate about her?

- 1. She may have disagreed with her father's decree of killing all the Hebrew male children.
- 2. She may have recognized the relationship between Miriam (Moses' sister) and the baby. That is why she trusted her to find a Hebrew woman to care for him.
- 3. She allowed Moses to stay with his parents for several years, long enough to be taught about God. (Hebrews 11:24-25)

Questions for discussion:

- 1. Why do you think the princess chose to keep Moses for herself?
- 2. What do you think the princess' hopes were for Moses as she raised him?
- 3. Why do you think God had Moses go through this tough experience?

What lessons can we learn?

- 1. God can use unexpected circumstances and people to accomplish His plan for your life!
- 2. Like the Princess training Moses in the ways of Egyptian royal court, maybe God is teaching you something today that He can use for His glory later in life.
- 3. Romans 8:28-29 God is at work in His, even when we don't understand what is happening in life!
