The Man Born Blind – John 9:1-38

What do we know about him from the Bible?

- 1. He was born blind. (9:1)
- 2. His blindness was not a punishment of sin.
- 3. He was blind so God could show His mighty power through healing his blindness. (9:3)
- 4. He was not shy. (9:9, 27)
- 5. He saw for the first time in his life. (9:7)

What can we speculate about him?

- The religious leaders evidently overlooked the miracle that this man could see because they were more interested in the fact that he was made to see on the Sabbath day!
- 2. The former blind man was frustrated with the religious leaders.
- 3. This man became a shameless follower of Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Do you think the blind man was bitter when he realized his blindness was so God's power could be shown through him?(Had this man known anything but being blind?)
- 2. What do the following verses remind us about God's plan, even when we don't understand it?
 - Jeremiah 29:11, Philippians 1:6, Romans 8:28-29

What Lessons can we Learn?

- 1. God will often use situations in our lives to make Himself known to us and others around us.
- 2. 1 Corinthians 10:13 shows my life is not all about me. It is to give glory to God.

("Glory" = giving others a high opinion concerning someone, resulting in praise, honor)
